ORDINANCE NO. 697

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PORTIONS OF SECTION 1(A), SECTION 6, AND SCHEDULE A OF ORDINANCE NO. 632 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Town of Lakeview ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 1(A) is amended in part to read as follows:

Add after the following language: ORS Chapter 481 through ORS Chapter 487 are re-adopted as amended or revised by the regular special sessions of the 1983 Oregon Legislature" as amended by Chapter 16 of the Session Laws of 1985."

- Section 2: Section 6 is amended to add a new subsection (5) which $\overline{\text{will read}}$ as follows:
 - "(5) No boat, trailer, travel trailer, or motor home shall be parked upon any street, alley or parking strip (area between curb and property line) for more than three (3) days except in the event of an emergency.
 - In the event of an emergency, it shall be located in a location which will minimize hazard to vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
 - The casual movement of any boat, trailer, travel trailer or motor home shall not reactivate the three day provision."
- Section 3: The title of Schedule A Restricted Parking is amended to read as follows:

"Schedule A - Restricted Parking - Motor Vehicles"

Section 4: Emergency Clause: In as much as the provisions of this ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, safety and welfare of the citizens and inhabitants of the Town of Lakeview, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by not less than 3/4 of the Town Council and its approval by the Mayor of the Town of Lakeview, Oregon.

Passed by not less than 3/4 of the Common Council and approved by the Mayor this 29 day of December, 1987.
