



# 2022 Small City Allotment Grant Application

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** The Small City Allotment Program is designed to help Oregon cities, with populations of 5,000 or less, repair or reconstruct streets that are inadequate for the capacity they serve or are in a condition detrimental to safety. A sum of \$5M is allocated each year per a competitive grant process with a maximum award of \$250,000 per selected project. Projects are required to be completed within two years from the agreement execution date. This year applications will be accepted July 1st through August 31st. Cities may have no more than one active project as of September 1, 2022 to be eligible to apply for this round of funding.

**DEADLINE:** Applications are due by 11:59pm on August 31, 2022.

**SCORING CRITERIA:** Projects are required to address either safety or capacity issues, projects that best meet this criteria will score the highest. An ODOT representative will perform a site evaluation on each eligible proposal; projects will be scored and ranked to determine which should be given priority. Scoring is based on current conditions and proposed improvements.

## Problem Statement

**Describe existing conditions and how they present either a safety or capacity issue.**

This section of Roberta Road serves as a central access road to Collins sawmill and Warner Creek Correctional Facilities. Both facilities are significant employers for Lakeview, with over 400 cars traveling Roberta weekly at any given time. There are over 40 homes on this section of Roberta Road, adding additional traffic & transportation volumes. Among utility cuts in the road, Roberta has dangerous potholes causing damage to tires and suspensions, poorly painted lines, and irregularities from improper grading where water has pooled, creating uneven surfaces. During the winter months, the road becomes more dangerous when visibility is unclear as drivers easily miscalculate hidden compromised road irregularities. Repair is a critical need.

## Project Description

**Describe the proposed project and how it will address the issues described above.**

Roberta Road is a critical transportation road and well as a crucial contributor to the economic development and growth of Lakeview. We propose grading and smoothing the road's surface to accommodate traffic demands and allow the road to perform better for motorists. The project will fix the critical issues that potholes are creating for motorists and then apply an asphalt overlay for a robust optimal improvement for the demands of traffic traveling Roberta.
