The council will meet in executive session under ORS 192.660(2)(d) - To consider the employment agreements (CBA) of a public officer, employee, staff member, or individual agent. This provision provides a legal framework for public bodies in Oregon to conduct confidential labor negotiations while ensuring procedural transparency and adherence to public meeting laws.

The public will not be permitted to attend the executive sessions; provided, however, representatives of the news media and designated staff will be allowed to attend the executive sessions. Representatives of the news media are specifically directed not to report on any deliberations conducted during the executive sessions, except to state the general subject of the executive sessions as previously announced. No decision will be made in the executive sessions.
